Successfully called for business and corporate tax reforms that freed **144,000 small businesses** from the gross receipts tax and returned \$400 million in one-time tax relief and another \$150 million in ongoing tax cuts for businesses across the state.

Secured the nation's fourth education savings accounts program and protected the program from legal challenges all the way up to the Tennessee Supreme Court, leading to more than **3,000 children enrolling in the program** in its first full year.



Stopped the largest proposed welfare expansion in state history that would have resulted in one-in-four Tennesseans enrolling in the state Medicaid program, while successfully calling for welfare reform to help move Tennesseans from poverty to prosperity.

**Ended collective bargaining** by education labor unions.

Protected the **rights of patients and doctors** to enter into direct primary care agreements.

Passed the nation's first ever **Right to Earn a Living Act** to curb the harmful impact of unnecessary occupational licensing regulations, which impact some **two million Tennesseans.** 



Repealed five entire licensing regimes through advocacy and strategic litigation, including hair braiding, shampooing, locksmiths, animal massage therapists, and beauty pageant operators, eliminating the licensing requirements for more than 4,000 workers.


